

Kate Aksonova. Mice and bat.



Stage is glade. Black Bat is inside bushes on the corner. Bat is squeezing.



BAT: It is morning. I am lost. I never find my way back home. Mother told me to be on time. I just want to see the sun. It is so shiny. And now I lost. What happen to me at day? I can't help myself. Oh, my wings. They stuck. I am unhappy.

Bat squeaks.

On stage comes Green Mouse, she is happy.



GREEN MOUSE: Day is very nice. Sun is lovely.

BAT: Help!

GREEN MOUSE: Who is crying?

BAT: Me. I'm in the bush.

GREEN MOUSE: I see you.



BAT: Help me.

GREEN MOUSE: Who are you? You are black and big. Are you a cat?

BAT: No. I'm bat.

GREEN MOUSE: Bat or cat?

BAT: Bat. Did you hear about mice who could fly?

GREEN MOUSE: I heard this story from my mother many times.

BAT: It's me.

GREEN MOUSE: Can you fly?

BAT: Yes.

GREEN MOUSE: Do you always have wings?

BAT: As I remember.

GREEN MOUSE: I wish I could fly.

BAT: I also can't now.

GREEN MOUSE: Why?

BAT: Mother told me not to fly in the morning. And I want to see sun. And here I stuck in bushes.

GREEN MOUSE: Sun is wonderful!

BAT: Yes.

GREEN MOUSE: I try to help you.

BAT: Please!

Green Mouse pulls few twigs on self.



GREEN MOUSE: Can you fly now?

BAT: No. Wings in twigs.

GREEN MOUSE: I know what to do. I ask my friends and we could help you.

Green Mouse goes away.



BAT: Strange bat without wings. But she is good and she has friends who could help me.

Green Mouse returns, with her Yellow Mouse and Red Mouse.



GREEN MOUSE: Here we are!

YELLOW MOUSE: Bat is real!

RED MOUSE: Bat exists!

BAT: If you about me... Yes. And I need your help.

GREEN MOUSE: I told you!

RED MOUSE: We see.

YELLOW MOUSE: You can fly!

BAT: Yes, but not now.

GREEN MOUSE: We try to help you.

Mice try to pull on self twigs.



BAT: Not enough.

RED MOUSE: We try.

YELLOW MOUSE: One more time.

BAT: It didn't work.

GREEN MOUSE: We will do that.

Blue Mouse runs on stage.



BLUE MOUSE: When I heard! I run, I run. And I'm here now.

GREEN MOUSE: We need your help.

BLUE MOUSE: I need to breath. Is bat a real mouse who could fly?



BAT: Yes. But now I need your help.

YELLOW MOUSE: The more mice the better.

RED MOUSE: We will help you.

BLUE MOUSE: Yes. Now me with you and we do all.

GREEN MOUSE: All now!

Mice pull twigs.



BAT: And me!

Bat pulls last twig.



BAT: I'm free!

Mice help Bat to come from bush.



YELLOW MOUSE: You are real!

BAT: Yes.

GREEN MOUSE: And now we are friends!

BAT: Forever!

RED MOUSE: Can you teach us to fly?

BAT: You haven't wings.

BLUE MOUSE: Is it necessary?

BAT: I think.

YELLOW MOUSE: That's life.

BAT: Without you I will stay in that tree forever. Thank you.

RED MOUSE: Not a problem.

YELLOW MOUSE: We could help you when we are together.

BLUE MOUSE: It's pity that we can't fly.

BAT: Yes and I can't teach you.

GREEN MOUSE: Yes.

All mice are sad.

BAT: I can't teach you. But I can fly with you on my back.

GREEN MOUSE: Hurray!

BAT: The more mice the better!

Kate Aksonova. Mice and cheese.



Stage is glade, flowers and grass.

Red Mouse enters.



RED MOUSE: I'm first. Sunny day. (looks around)



Nobody is here. I'll wait.

Mouse runs on stage, then stops on the centre of the stage.

RED MOUSE: It's not good to play alone. I hear, somebody is coming.



Yellow Mouse runs on stage.



YELLOW MOUSE: I think I would be first today. Today is sunny day.

RED MOUSE: I was first today. We could play.

YELLOW MOUSE: Yes.



Mice start to run on circle by each other.



RED MOUSE: It is good to play together.

YELLOW MOUSE: It is great to run together.

Enters Green Mouse.



GREEN MOUSE: Are you playing already?

RED MOUSE: Come to us.

YELLOW MOUSE: It is more fun when we are three.

GREEN MOUSE: The more mice the better.

Three mice run on circle by each other, squeak.



RED MOUSE: Hurray to mice!

YELLOW MOUSE: Hurray!

Enters Blue Mouse.



BLUE MOUSE: I am late today. And I want to run with you.

RED MOUSE: Catch me. Catch me up.

YELLOW MOUSE: How fun it is to run.

GREEN MOUSE: The more mice the better.

BLUE MOUSE: Hurray to mice!

RED MOUSE: It is good to be with all of you.

Mice run.



On stage rolls out cheese.



Mice don't notice.

Cheese knocks down Blue Mouse and she falls.



All mice stop.

Blue Mouse squeezes pitiful. Mice help her to stand up again.



BLUE MOUSE: What happened?

YELLOW MOUSE: Really, what happened?

RED MOUSE: Why did you fall?

BLUE MOUSE: Somebody pushed me.

GREEN MOUSE: It's not me.

RED MOUSE: Not me.

YELLOW MOUSE: Not me either.

BLUE MOUSE: Then who?

GREEN MOUSE: Maybe stone.

Mice turn around on their places and only now notice cheese and start to smell it.



BLUE MOUSE: It is cheese.

YELLOW MOUSE: Cheese!

RED MOUSE: Cheese!

GREEN MOUSE: Cheese!

RED MOUSE: Where is it from?

YELLOW MOUSE: It doesn't matter.

BLUE MOUSE: Yes, it is my cheese.

GREEN MOUSE: Why?

BLUE MOUSE: It fell on me, and it is mine.

Blue Mouse carries off cheese.



RED MOUSE: Stop!

BLUE MOUSE: Why? I want to eat my cheese.

YELLOW MOUSE: It is not fair.

GREEN MOUSE: Yes.

RED MOUSE: It is not fair. This cheese is mine.

BLUE MOUSE: Why?

RED MOUSE: Today I was first to come.

GREEN MOUSE: And?

RED MOUSE: I just put this cheese away before run.

GREEN MOUSE: You didn't say that you bring cheese with you.

RED MOUSE: Yes. I didn't want you know about it.

Red Mouse takes cheese for herself.



YELLOW MOUSE: It is not right.

BLUE MOUSE: It is not your cheese.

GREEN MOUSE: And not yours.

RED MOUSE: Yes.

Red Mouse lets go cheese.



GREEN MOUSE: Then cheese is mine.

YELLOW MOUSE: Mine.

Green Mouse and Yellow Mouse catch cheese.



BLUE MOUSE: It doesn't help.

Mice let go cheese and stay around it.



YELLOW MOUSE: What we do now?

GREEN MOUSE: We forget about cheese.

BLUE MOUSE: It is hard.

RED MOUSE: Yes.

All mice sigh.

YELLOW MOUSE: I want to play.

BLUE MOUSE: At first we need to know what to do with cheese.

RED MOUSE: Yes, whose it.

GREEN MOUSE: No one...

YELLOW MOUSE: But...

GREEN MOUSE: And everyone.

BLUE MOUSE: I don't understand.

GREEN MOUSE: We found it.

RED MOUSE: Yes.

GREEN MOUSE: And we all want cheese.

YELLOW MOUSE: Yes.

GREEN MOUSE: We will have it.

BLUE MOUSE: But we talked about it.

GREEN MOUSE: Yes. We could have just piece of it.

RED MOUSE: To everyone.

GREEN MOUSE: Yes.

YELLOW MOUSE: Nice.

GREEN MOUSE: Take your cheese!

Each mice break off equal piece of cheese and smell it.



BLUE MOUSE: It would be nice to have more cheese.

GREEN MOUSE: What for?

BLUE MOUSE: We know what to do with it.

YELLOW MOUSE: Yes.

RED MOUSE: Eat it!

Mice squeeze and jump with piece of cheese.

Kate Aksonova. Mice and puddle.



Shining big “puddle” is on the middle of the stage.



Blue Mouse enters on stage.



BLUE MOUSE: I am happy. Rain stopped. Mother let me go to play. I hope, all mice come.

Blue Mouse comes to border of the “puddle” and wets her feet.



BLUE MOUSE: What is it? It wasn't here before.

Blue Mouse bents above and smells “puddle”. After it she stays still surprises.



BLUE MOUSE: It's cold and wet. But...

Blue Mouse stands thoughtful near "puddle".



BLUE MOUSE: I can't be wrong, someone is there.

Blue Mouse again bents above "puddle" .



BLUE MOUSE: Hello! What do you do there? I don't know you. And I know all blue mice. Why are you silent? Hello!

Blue Mouse turns over from "puddle" and looks around.



BLUE MOUSE: Now, I need tell everyone that I saw new blue mouse. But she is silent. I need to tell to everyone.

Blue Mouse bents over "puddle".



BLUE MOUSE: Wait here. I will return soon.

Blue Mouse runs away.



Red Mouse comes on stage.



RED MOUSE: Strange. Nobody is here. Rain stopped. Where are everyone?

Red Mouse comes to "puddle" and bends over and looks inside it.



RED MOUSE: What is wet and cold? Hello! What are you doing here? I know all the red mice. Who are you?

Red Mouse looks around.



RED MOUSE: Nobody is here. I need to tell that we have new red mouse.

Red Mouse bents over "puddle".



RED MOUSE: Wait for me here. I will be fast. Why are you quiet? Mice have to be together.

Red Mouse runs away.



On stage run Red Mouse and Blue Mouse. Yellow Mouse runs after them.



YELLOW MOUSE: Why we all run?

RED MOUSE: Did you hear what I tell you?

BLUE MOUSE: No, important what I told you.

YELLOW MOUSE: You spoke together and I didn't understand anything.

BLUE MOUSE: Listen.

Red Mouse and Blue Mouse close “puddle” by themselves and speak.



RED MOUSE: Like I already told you, today I came first. Rain stopped. And I came here to play. And here it is!

BLUE MOUSE: Yes. Wet and cold.

YELLOW MOUSE: What?

RED MOUSE: It doesn't matter.

BLUE MOUSE: Yes.

YELLOW MOUSE: What are you talking about?

RED MOUSE: About mouse.

YELLOW MOUSE: Which mouse?

BLUE MOUSE: Blue mouse.

RED MOUSE: Red mouse.

BLUE MOUSE: Blue.

RED MOUSE: Red.

BLUE MOUSE: Blue.

RED MOUSE: Red.

BLUE MOUSE: Blue!

RED MOUSE: Red!!

YELLOW MOUSE: Quiet!

BLUE MOUSE: Mouse was blue.

RED MOUSE: No, red.

YELLOW MOUSE: Stop. Where did you find...

BLUE MOUSE: Red.

RED MOUSE: Blue!

YELLOW MOUSE: That mouse.

RED MOUSE: Here.

YELLOW MOUSE: Where?

BLUE MOUSE: Right here.

All three mice come to "puddle".



YELLOW MOUSE: Where are they now?

RED MOUSE: I hope, where they were before.

BLUE MOUSE: Inside.

Mice bend above "puddle".



RED MOUSE: Do you see?

YELLOW MOUSE: Yes.

BLUE MOUSE: Blue.

RED MOUSE: Red.

YELLOW MOUSE: No, yellow.

RED MOUSE: What?

BLUE MOUSE: Where?

YELLOW MOUSE: Here.

Mice with amusement look at each other.



RED MOUSE: How many mice are there?

BLUE MOUSE: One blue mouse.

YELLOW MOUSE: One yellow mouse.

RED MOUSE: And one red mouse. Three mice. Interesting.

YELLOW MOUSE: Yes. But they all are silent.

BLUE MOUSE: Yes. They are together. As we are.

RED MOUSE: Yes. The more mice the better.

BLUE MOUSE: Hurray! We found three new friends.

YELLOW MOUSE: Yes. It is not a problem that they are quiet. We are loud.

Mice start to jump.

YELLOW MOUSE: They are jumping!

RED MOUSE: We will play together.

BLUE MOUSE: Hurray to mice!

YELLOW MOUSE: Hurray!

Mice jump near the puddle. They are happy.

Kate Aksonova. Mice and stream.



“Stream” is on sand which divided stage on two parts.



From one part of stage run Yellow Mouse and Green Mouse.



GREEN MOUSE: It's a warm day!

YELLOW MOUSE: Yes, it is nice day to run. Look!

Both mice come closer to “stream”.



YELLOW MOUSE: That was not here yesterday.

GREEN MOUSE: Maybe it is rain.

YELLOW MOUSE: It can't be.

GREEN MOUSE: Why?

YELLOW MOUSE: Rain always drops from above.

GREEN MOUSE: You think I don't know that.

YELLOW MOUSE: Who knows.

GREEN MOUSE: Where is the rain when it is not on top?

YELLOW MOUSE: I don't know.

GREEN MOUSE: I see. Rain sleeps here.

YELLOW MOUSE: Really.

GREEN MOUSE: It looks like rain.

YELLOW MOUSE: I don't know. But it is wet and cold and could be the rain.

Mice bend over stream.



GREEN MOUSE: What is now?

YELLOW MOUSE: We have to leave.

GREEN MOUSE: Why?

YELLOW MOUSE: Do you want to wake up the rain?

GREEN MOUSE: We could play near it as loud as we could. And nothing will happen.

YELLOW MOUSE: How do you know?

GREEN MOUSE: I already did this.

YELLOW MOUSE: Really?!

GREEN MOUSE: Once.

From another part of stage come to "stream" Blue Mouse and Red Mouse.



BLUE MOUSE: Hello!

RED MOUSE: Nice day to run!

YELLOW MOUSE: Yes.

GREEN MOUSE: But how?

RED MOUSE: Come to us.

YELLOW MOUSE: We can't.

BLUE MOUSE: We also can't.

GREEN MOUSE: Does somebody could swim?

BLUE MOUSE: No.

YELLOW MOUSE: Here sleeps the rain.

RED MOUSE: Because of this water is there.

GREEN MOUSE: Yes.

RED MOUSE: We could run at both sides from it.

BLUE MOUSE: Nice plan.

YELLOW MOUSE: Nice idea.

Mice start to run at both sides of "stream". Green Mouse stops and starts to think.



GREEN MOUSE: We must run together.

YELLOW MOUSE: How?

GREEN MOUSE: We need to put something on the rain that we could stay on it and don't drown.

BLUE MOUSE: Great.

GREEN MOUSE: I know.

RED MOUSE: What?

YELLOW MOUSE: Stones.

GREEN MOUSE: Of course.

YELLOW MOUSE: They are always not in water.

BLUE MOUSE: We go and find few.

Mice run from stage.



Yellow Mouse and Green Mouse come back and pull big stone.



And after that they put it near the "stream". They puff.



YELLOW MOUSE: Do you think it is all?

GREEN MOUSE: Of course not. We need more.

Green Mouse and Yellow Mouse exit.



Red Mouse and Blue Mouse pull not so big stone but sight loudly.



They also put stone near "stream".



RED MOUSE: Do you think we need more stones?

BLUE MOUSE: Yes.

RED MOUSE: Go for them.

Red Mouse and Blue Mouse exit.



On stage come Green Mouse, Yellow Mouse, Red Mouse and Blue Mouse each one of them pull one stone. Blue Mouse pulls the biggest stone.



YELLOW MOUSE: Hurray to mice!

BLUE MOUSE: Yees!

RED MOUSE: What now?

GREEN MOUSE: Put them on the rain.

BLUE MOUSE: How?

GREEN MOUSE: Step on one stone and put the next near.

YELLOW MOUSE: It is easy than I thought.

Blue Mouse steps on stone and puts hers stone.



After it she steps on hers stone.



BLUE MOUSE: We need more stones.

YELLOW MOUSE: Yes, we need.

Yellow Mouse puts hers stone, helps herself with paws.



RED MOUSE: With my stone will be good.

Red Mouse goes and puts her stone.



RED MOUSE: We need one more.

GREEN MOUSE: What I said!

Green Mouse puts hers stone.



It is enough stones. Green Mouse goes on another part of stage.



RED MOUSE: The more mice the better!

YELLOW MOUSE: We could play together.

BLUE MOUSE: We bring that stones.

GREEN MOUSE: Hurray to mice!

BLUE MOUSE: Hurray!

Mice step on the stones above “stream” and jump.



YELLOW MOUSE: We are together!

BLUE MOUSE: The more stones the better!
